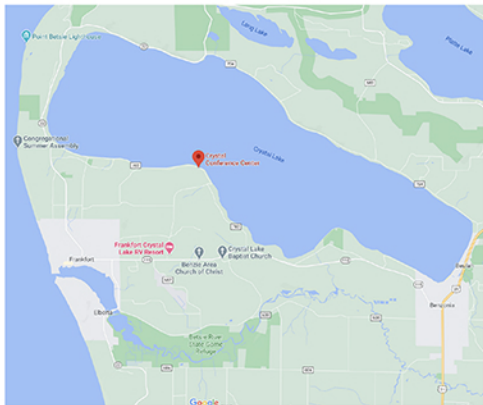
SCHOLARSHIPS

AGE FIVE TO ENTERING GRADE SIX
